## THE BLUEVILLE STORY

Blueville Nursery was established in 1933 by Marlin and Gladys Scott on Bluevine Road in Manhattan, Kansas. They operated it until 1962 when Darrell and Dorothy Westervelt purchased the nursery. Blueville Nursery moved to its current location in 1969 which was, at that time, their growing field established in 1963. A small Garden Store was then started opening in the spring of 1970.

The nursery was incorporated in 1972 so that other employees could acquire part of the company's ownership. Blueville currently has 19 stockholders including Keith Westervelt. Keith was elected President and CEO in December 1998 and has retained a little over 50% ownership of the corporation.

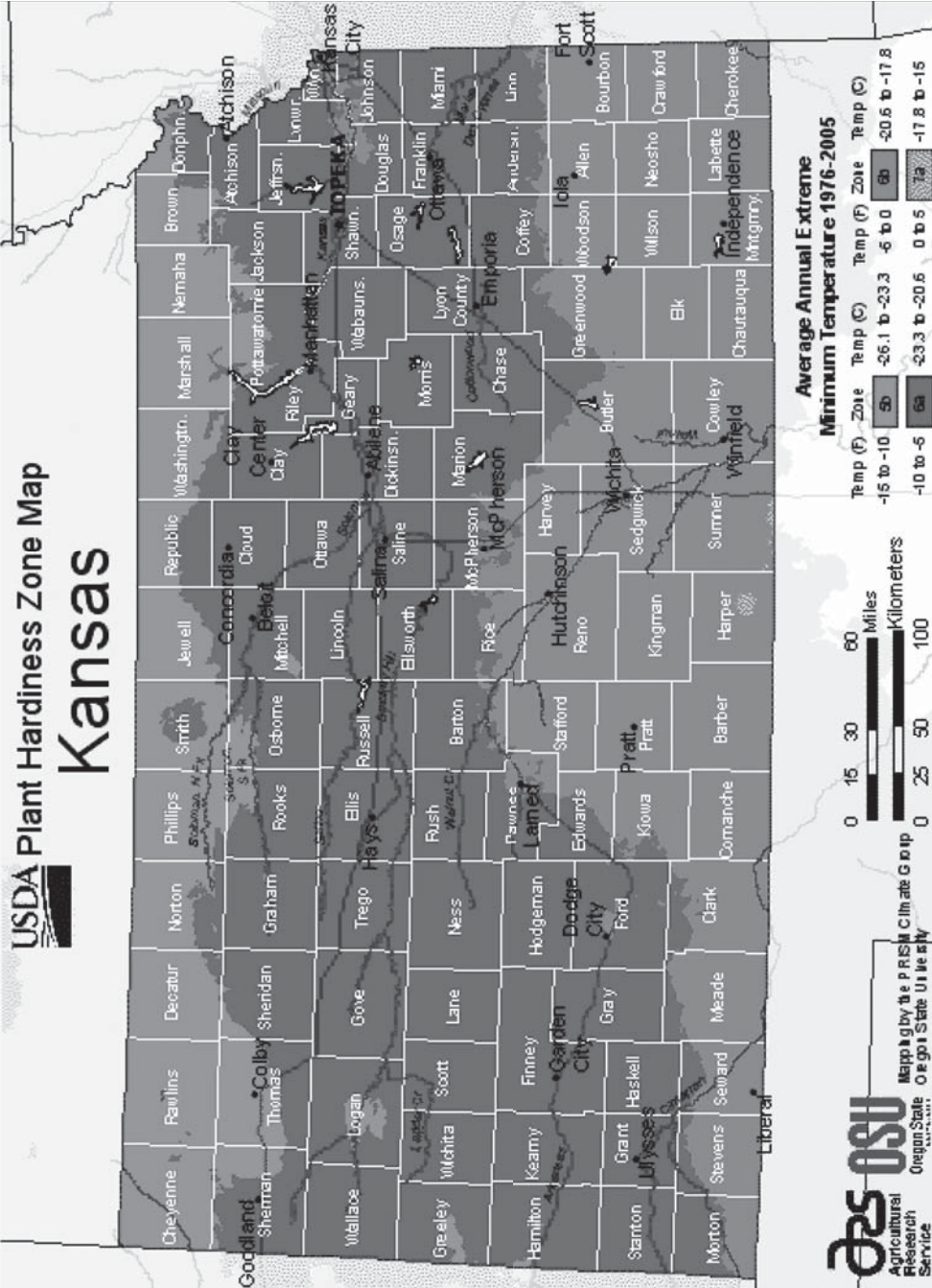
The Nursery contains about 45 acres of which about 20 are devoted to growing trees, evergreens and shrubs. Growing is done primarily for our landscaping and retail sales with surplus plants being marketed wholesale. The nursery also buys plants to re-wholesale to other nurseries and landscapers.

The Blueville staff consists of long-time, year-round staff and many part-time and temporary employees. Blueville promotes a family-like atmosphere creating many long-standing employees. During the busy spring and fall seasons there are over 120 employees on payroll. Younger employees are constantly being recruited to maintain vigor and add new ideas.

Blueville considers its retail trade territory to be about a 100-mile radius from Manhattan with most landscape work done in Manhattan, Junction City, Clay Center, and Wamego.

For management and record keeping the business is divided into 7 areas: Garden Store, Irrigation, Landscape, Maintenance, Nursery (growing), Ft. Riley, and Administration. Since purchasing the nursery in 1962 Blueville Nursery has never had an unprofitable year. Blueville Nursery is the largest nursery in Kansas outside of the large metro areas (Wichita and Kansas City). Our company continues to improve our facilities and equipment and add new services and merchandise.

With 54 plus years of experience, Blueville prides itself on our trained professionals, progressive knowledge, quality of work, and our deep roots in the Manhattan and surrounding areas.

## FRUIT TREES

**APPLE** 5 gallon: \$60 7 gallon: \$75

### SEMI-DWARF JONATHAN

Mature size: 10' x 10'

Pollinator Required: No - But for better production use a pollinator.

Fruit is medium-sized, bright red and aromatic with crisp and juicy flavor. Good for dessert and cooking. Fruit matures in late September

### SEMI-DWARF RED DELICIOUS

Mature size - 12'-15'

Disease Resistance: Good

Pollinator required: Yes - Can be pollinated with any variety Fruit.

Matures in mid-October. Red Fruit that is rich and sweet. Good for fresh eating and salads. Crisp and juicy flavor. Does very well without spraying. Matures in September.

### FUJI APPLE

Mature size - 15' x 15'

Disease Resistance: Good

Pollinator required: Yes - Can be pollinated with any other apple variety.

Very good eating apple. Harvest in October.

### GALA APPLE

Mature size - 15' x 15'

Disease Resistance: Good

Pollinator required: Yes - Can be pollinated with any other apple variety.

Crisp white apple. Harvest in October.

### GRANNY SMITH APPLE

Mature size - 10' x 10'

Disease Resistance : Fair

Pollinator required: Yes - can be pollinated with any other apple variety.

This apple has a crisp bite and tart flavor. Fruit keeps up to six months in the refrigerator. Heat-tolerant. Ripens in early November.

### HONEYCRISP APPLE

Mature size - 10' x 10'

Disease Resistance: Fair

Pollinator required: Yes - Can be pollinated with any other apple variety.

Crisp, cream-colored flesh is mild, sweet and aromatic. Cold-hardy. Ripens early September.

### YELLOW DELICIOUS

Mature size - 12'-15'

Disease Resistance: Good

Pollinator required: Yes - Can be pollinated with any variety Fruit, excellent pollinator for other varieties. Fruit matures in mid-October. Bright yellow fruit great for fresh eating and baking.

## APRICOT

### TILTON

Mature size - 12' x 12'

Pollinator required: No

Great apricot for canning, excellent fresh or dried as well. Medium to large, firm, rich flavor

## FRUIT TREES

### CHERRY 5 Gallon: \$60

#### BING

Mature height: 15'-25'

Pollinator Required: Yes - Best pollinated with Stella

Solid fleshed black cherry with high quality flavor. Fruit matures mid June.

#### MONTMORENCY PIE

Mature size: 12' x 12'

Disease Resistance: Excellent

Pollinator Required: No - Self pollinating

Medium-large cherries with a juicy, sweet rich tart, slightly tangy flavor. The standard for Kansas pie cherries. Fruit matures in late June.

#### NORTH STAR PIE

Mature size: 10' x 10'

Disease Resistance: Excellent

Pollinator Required: No - Self pollinating

Large, juicy fruit; tart/sour flavor. Great pie cherry. Fruit matures early June.

#### STELLA

Mature size: 12' x 12'

A self pollinating sweet cherry. Dark red, sweet firm fruit, great for eating right off the tree. Ripens in late July

### PEACH 5 Gallon: \$60

#### RED HAVEN

Mature size: 10' x 10'

Pollinator Required: No - Self Pollinating

Golden to red fruit. Firm flesh with a great flavor. Good for freezing and canning. One of the hardiest peaches. Fruit matures in July to early August.

#### RELIANCE

Mature size: 10' x 10'

Pollinator Required: No - Self pollinating

Hardest yellow peach available. Medium sized fruit is soft and juicy. Perfect for farmer's markets as fresh fruit. Fruit matures in early August.

### PEAR 5 Gallon: \$60

#### BARTLETT

Mature size: 15' x 15'

Disease resistance: Moderate

Large golden fruit with great quality. Buttery, juicy and with lots of flavor. Excellent for canning or eating. Fruits ripen in September.

#### LUCIOUS PEAR

Disease resistance: Good

Pollinator required: yes

This pear has firm flesh to the core when ripe. Fruit is medium-size and matures around early September.

#### RED ANJOU PEAR

Mature size – 12' x 12'

Disease resistance: Good

Pollinator required: yes

A red skin pear with soft, juicy flesh and a sweet, mild flavor. Excellent keeper. Flavor peaks about 2 months after harvest. Color improves in storage.

### PLUM

#### SANTA ROSA

Mature size: 15' x 15' Disease resistance: Good

Pollinator required: No

Large sweet fruit that matures in July. Clingstone.

#### SATSUMA

Mature size : 15' x 15'

Pollinator required: Yes

The Satsuma plum is a large Japanese variety of dark, solid red skin and dark red flesh. The fruit is firm and juicy. The Satsuma plum needs a pollinator to produce heavy crops in late July to early August.

#### STANLEY

Mature size: 15' x 15'

Fruit is oval, with deep-purple skin and golden, freestone flesh. Tastes great fresh picked, but this plum is equally tasty when it is dried or canned.

## FRUIT VINES

### BLACKBERRY 1 Gallon: \$18

#### ARAPAHO

Height: 4'-5'

Arapaho Blackberry Plants are a thornless, cold hardy disease resistant blackberry cultivar. They do not need a trellis and have an excellent flavor. Ripens earlier than other varieties in June.

#### BLACK SATIN

Height: 5' x 5'

This thornless, heat tolerant blackberry is a prolific producer of deliciously sweet and juicy, deep blue-black berries.

#### CHESTER

Height: 3'-4'

A thornless variety with medium to large deep black berries. A high yielding variety with sweet tasting fruit. A great choice for making blackberry wine.

## FRUIT VINES

### **BLUEBERRY** 1 Gallon: \$18

*Blueberries need acidic and evenly moist soil with heavy mulch. Best planted with another variety for pollination. Check with the Garden Store to see how to amend your soils and care for plants.*

#### **DARROW**

Mature size: 5' x 5'

A late-season ripening variety, Darrow produces giant berries on upright branches with an open growth habit.

#### **BLUECROP**

Mature size: 5' x 5'

Produces big clusters of large, all-purpose berries. Ripens in July, produces better with a pollinator.

### **GOOSEBERRY** 1 Gallon: \$18

#### **PIXWELL**

Height: 4'-5'

Pale green fruit becomes pink when ripe. Very few thorns. Produces on 2-to 3-year-old wood.

### **GRAPE** 1 Gallon: \$18

#### **CATWABA**

Mature size – 7' x 10'

Good for table use, juice, jelly, champagne and red wine. Hardy vines produce large clusters of medium-size, sweet red slip-skin fruit. Grapes ripen in late September.

#### **CONCORD SEEDLESS**

Height: 15'

Very popular seedless variety with great flavor, vigor and productivity. Blue-black berries ripen in late summer after attractive white flowers.

### **RASPBERRY** 1 Gallon: \$18

#### **LATHAM**

Height: 4' x 4'

Nice sized berries with glowing, pure red color, plus wonderfully sweet flavor. Firm, delicious fruit processes that are great for jams and jellies.

#### **CANBY RED**

Height: 5' to 10'

This tasty, almost thornless Red Raspberry produces large, tasty bright red berries of good quality.

### ELM *Extremely tough with graceful oval to vase shape*

This includes the early large flowering varieties such as the double, semi-double and mid-season clematis. They produce flowers on old or previous season's stems. Pruning this group should be done in April or early May. Remove all dead and weak stems, then simply trim the remaining stems enough to keep it under control. All remaining stems need to be tied to give space for new growth.

#### GROUP 3: HARD PRUNING

This group bears their flowers on new growth each year, and, in most cases, each stem produces several flowers. The old or previous season's growth dies back naturally each winter. Therefore, all old growth must be removed to allow for new growth. Prune this group in late April or early May depending on weather. Pruning consists of removing all old top growth down to about 12-18" above ground level.

Regardless of flowering habits, all clematis should be pruned hard, to 12-18" from the ground the first spring after planting. This helps encourage a sturdier, more heavily branched base, making the vine more durable.
